Even though the recognition from AKC with the certificates and bling was nice, the biggest reward for Henry and I are all the amazing experi-




ences we shared while bringing some cheer to other people who needed to be cheered up.

Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes on Sunday (REGIONAL SPECIALTY DAY) - Newfoundland exhibitors can participate in a second Sweepstakes & Veteran Sweepstakes Event on Sunday as part of the All-Breed Sweepstakes offered by the Kalamazoo Kennel Club.
